The Louisa Creekwatch Program would appeal to those interested in water quality in urban areas and issues concerning riparian vegetation and creek ecology. The team gets involved in many events and welcomes the participation from any members of the Townsville community.

WHAT IS LOUISA CREEKWATCH?

Louisa Creekwatch is a volunteer program that spends one day a week monitoring water quality, populations raising fish and awareness οf water quality issues in Louisa Creek. team also gets involved in many special events such as catchment tours, tilapia fishing competitions and assisting school groups in creek based activities.

Louisa Creekwatch is a component of the "Creek to Coral" program beina implemented in the Townsville Thuringowa coastal plain. Creek to Coral aims "to maintain sustainable clean wetlands and waterways (both fresh and marine) from creek to coral within the Townsville Thuringowa Coastal Dry Tropic Catchments".
