Community Planting in Your Neighbourhood



Townsville City Council is planning a community tree planting as part of the Greening Townsville Program in your local area. The planting is part of an on-going commitment to helping achieve a Townsville that is Clean and Green and builds on the recent environmental drainage works undertaken by Citiworks in the area. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will provide shade and enhance the habitat values for local flora and fauna.

- » **When:** Saturday 31 March 2007
- » **Where:** MacArthur Park, corner of Macarthur Drive & Verbena Court - Annandale (meet near the picnic table)
- » **Time:** 8am - 11am
- » **What to bring:** Hat, gloves, sturdy and enclosed footwear, sunscreen, drinking water
- » **Free BBQ and drinks after planting and take a free local native plant to plant at home.**

Everyone is welcome to participate in our Community Greening events. All site preparation (including hole digging) will be done by Council's Greening and Waterway team prior to the event. Activities on the day will include tree planting, fertilising, mulching and watering. Ongoing site maintenance and watering will be a council responsibility.
