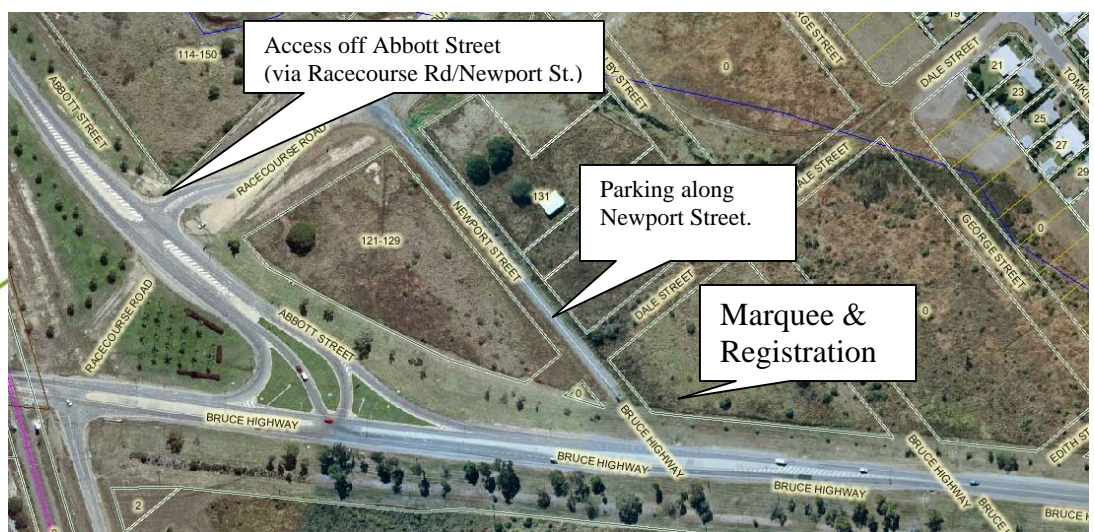
Community Planting in Your Neighbourhood

Townsville City Council is planning a community tree planting as part of the Greening Townsville Program in your local area. The planting is part of an on-going commitment to helping achieve a Townsville that is Clean and Green. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will provide an avenue of greeneries and shade along Bruce Highway as well as enhance amenity.

- » **When:** Sunday 18 November 2007
- » **Where:** Bruce Highway (after the turn off from Abbott Street) see map for access to site
- » **Time:** 8am - 11am
- » **What to bring:** Hat, gloves, sturdy and enclosed footwear, sunscreen, drinking water
- » **Free BBQ and drinks after planting and take a free local native plant to plant at home.**

Everyone is welcome to participate in our Community Greening events. All site preparation (including holes digging) will be done by Council's Greening and Waterway team prior to the event. Activities on the day will include tree planting, fertilising, mulching and watering. Ongoing site maintenance and watering will be a council responsibility.
