Townsville City Council, in conjunction with Community Water Grants and Bungalow Bay, is planning a community tree planting in your local area. This planting is a continuation of the original plantings which commenced in September 2006. The creek rehabilitation and revegetation project starts at Bungalow Bay and down through the Council's Old Schoolhouse Reserve and Horseshoe Bay Environmental Reserve to the mangrove wetland. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will enhance the habitat values for local flora and fauna.

- » **What to bring:** Hat, gloves, sturdy and enclosed footwear, sunscreen, drinking water
