To celebrate National Tree Day, Townsville City Council, in conjunction with Gustav Creek Catchment Care and Australian Government Envirofund, is hosting a community tree planting along Gustav Creek. The planting will be a combination of local native trees and shrubs which will enhance the habitat values of the Gustav Creek riparian zone. The planting will be followed by a Creek Rehabilitation Workshop for residents interested in rehabilitating gardens adjacent to Gustav Creek.
